ACHIEVEMENTS

- Directed 30 officers and 300 men who used U.S. and Vietnamese physicians, foods, cash and rebuilding materials to replace homes and roads destroyed by war, among 144,000 people in six cities to encourage their political allegiance toward their national government.
- Received the Bronze Star Medal and the Outstanding Company Grade officer award from field of 10,000 U.S. Air Force candidates.
- Served as Generals' Aide to Chief of Staff, a Major General of a Joint Command over 30,000 U.S. troops south of Mexico in 17 Latin American Countries. Visited and escorted Pentagon officials to each president or their chief of staff. Speak Spanish fluently.
- Recruited to teach the 286 safeguards in the U.S. Constitution to approximately 10,000 people at 66 seminars under the direction of Dr. W. Cleon Skousen, founder of the National Center for Constitutional Studies, Utah and Constitutional advisor to President R. Reagan.

- Hosted radio talk show morning and nightly 5 of 7 nights for the American Freedom Network, Johnstown, CO.
- Analyzed California State Constitution to recommend the right place to include the sense of the U.S. tenth Amendment. Now in Judiciary Committee.
